**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Commissioners of Penobscot
County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Penobscot County: County commissioners, ~~\$3,000~~ \$3,300; chairman, ~~\$3,250~~ \$3,550; clerk of courts, \$6,600; deputy clerk of courts, \$5,500; county attorney, \$8,000; first assistant county attorney, \$6,000; second assistant county attorney, \$6,000; county treasurer, \$3,900; sheriff, \$7,000; register of deeds, \$6,000; judge of probate, \$7,000; register of probate, \$5,800.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of the county commissioners of Penobscot County by approximately 10% to keep such salaries in line with other county officers and employees.
