## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

### AN ACT to Extend Medical Assistance to Low Income People Not on State Catagorical Assistance Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$8,700,000 for the purpose of providing medical assistance for the medically indigent under Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3351. The breakdown shall be as follows:

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This is an Act intended to be a first step in meeting the medical needs of the medically indigent in compliance with Federal requirements, which call for comprehensive medical coverage of the medically indigent under Title XIX of the Social Security Act. An estimated 100,000 low income Maine residents who cannot now meet rising medical costs, who are not now eligible for State Administered categorical assistance programs, and therefore are being denied adequate medical care, would be provided for by the appropriation requested herein.
