HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 477, L. D. 618, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Committees on Status of Women, Children and Youth,
and the Aged."

Amend said Bill in section 1 of PART A by striking out in the 2nd
line (same in L. D.) the figure "30" and inserting in place
thereof the figure '28'; and by striking out in the 3rd and 4th
lines (3rd line of L. D.) the words and punctuation "the House of
Representatives, the Senate,"

Further amend said Bill in section 1 of PART A by inserting at the
end of the first sentence, before the period, the following:
'; and there shall be 2 additional members of the committee, one
from the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate and one
from the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of
the House'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 of PART B by striking
out all of the first sentence and inserting in place thereof
the following sentence:

'The Governor shall appoint an Advisory Council on the Status of
Women of 15 members, and there shall be appointed 2 additional
members of the council, one from the Senate appointed by the
President of the Senate and one from the House of Representatives,
appointed by the Speaker of the House, hereinafter in this Part
called the "council."'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 of PART C by striking
out all of the first sentence and inserting in place thereof
the following sentence:

(Filing No. H-242)

'The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint a Committee on Aging of 12 members, hereinafter in this Part called the "committee," and there shall be 2 additional members of the committee, one from the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate and one from the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the legislative members of the several committees shall be appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
