IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing Civilian Radio Operators for State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the State Police from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$62,385 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$89,865 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 and \$20,785 from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$29,955 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 to employ 20 civilian radio operators II.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the employment of 20 civilian radio operators so that state troopers, now being utilized as radio operators, may perform law enforcement duties.
