**AN ACT Relating to Return Envelopes for Absentee Ballots Designating
Official before Whom Ballot to Be Marked.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1252, sub-§ 1-A, additional. Section 1252 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 1-A, to read as follows:

1-A. Envelope. The return envelope shall indicate that any ballot marked outside the State shall be marked before a notary public having a seal or any diplomat or consular official of the United States.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to indicate on the return envelope for an absentee ballot the proper official before whom a voter outside the State should mark his ballot.
