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**AN ACT** Relating to Payment of Fees to Secretary of State for Reports of  
Records.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 55-B, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 55-B to read as follows:

§ 55-B. Reports of records

Reports of records pertaining to convictions, accidents, suspensions, revocations and other information required by commercial users shall be furnished by the Secretary of State at a fee of \$2 for each request upon receipt of such request from an individual, insurance company or other party requiring such information. This section shall not apply to other motor vehicle departments, state and federal agencies and law enforcement agencies. Certified copies shall be \$1 additional.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The \$2 fee will provide for the cost involved in processing record checks, etc. It will add to the dedicated revenue \$17,490 in the fiscal year 1971-72 and approximately the same amount in 1972-73.
