**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of District Court Judges.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 4, § 157, amended.** The 4th sentence of section 157 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 3 of chapter 580 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

Each judge shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$16,000~~ \$19,500 and the Chief Judge shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$17,000~~ \$20,500.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish an equitable salary relationship within the courts.

FISCAL NOTE

No appropriation is necessary. Funds are available with the District Court appropriation.
