HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 490, L. D. 631, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Records of Sales of Used Merchandise."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 456. Record of sales of used merchandise

No dealer in used personal property other than coins, stamps, scrap materials, motor vehicles or bulk purchases from estates shall buy any used personal property from any person without first recording in a book kept for the purpose a description of said personal property and the name and address of the seller of such property. Said record shall be made before said sale is completed and shall be open to the inspection of any law enforcement officer or prosecuting attorney. Any dealer who fails to keep such record or refuses to show the same to any law enforcement officer or prosecuting attorney shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500. Whoever gives a false or fictitious name to said dealer shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months. This section shall not apply to the sale of used personal property where the gross sales price is less than \$25 or to sales between dealers or to sales on consignment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to develop a record of ownership to pursue persons involved in crimes of stolen property.
