AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Drug Rehabilitation in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the York County Counseling Services from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 for the purpose of drug rehabilitation in York County, such rehabilitation to be administered by the Mental Health Center at Sweetser-Children's Home in Saco for York County residents.

STATEMENT OF FACT

These funds are to provide all professional services needed for drug rehabilitation — social service, psychiatric service, mental health services and hospitalization.
