**AN ACT to Authorize the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to
Appoint a Special Warden or Caretaker.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2001, amended. Section 2001 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the first paragraph the following new paragraph:

The commissioner may appoint a person as a game warden or caretaker to patrol and oversee a wildlife sanctuary, private game preserve or area set aside for propagation of wildlife. The powers of such person shall be limited to the area assigned.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This would permit the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to provide proper care for a specific wildlife preserve in accordance with the desire of a private donor.
