STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Upgrading the Classification of Certain Waters of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 368, amended. Subsection 19 of that part of section 368 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the waters captioned Penobscot River Basin, Piscataquis River Drainage System, as enacted by section 15 of chapter 304 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

19. Piscataquis River, main stem, from the railroad bridge approximately I mile east of Merrill Brook confluence to the bridge at East Dover—Class $\mathbf{D} \mathbf{C}$.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 38, § 369, amended. Subsection 24 of that part of section 369 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Washington County is amended to read as follows:

24. Unnamed Stream entering tidewater portion of St. Croix River at Calais crossing North Street between Beech and Union Streets—Class $\oplus C$.

Sec. 3. Time schedule. The time schedule for compliance with the foregoing reclassifications shall be as set forth in the Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 451, subsection 1, as amended.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to upgrade to Class C, 2 of the 4 remaining bodies of water in Maine still classified D, and to establish time schedules for compliance with the C classification.
