# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Repealing Law Providing for Statutory Agent for Foreign Domiciled Carriers Purchasing Semitrailer Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

The fee for such plate shall be \$5 for each registration year, or portion thereof, for the number of years of valid use from the year of issue to the end of the semipermanent plate program; and there shall be no refund of payment of such fee except as provided in section 154.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. The last paragraph of section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 163 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

After 2 years experience, it would seem to add no particular purpose in the registration of the so-called long-term trailer plates. The provision of refund is being used by registrants to request rebate of fees for plates which were issued in 1968.
