SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 507, L. D. 659, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a Human Rights Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Executive Department, Human Rights Commission the sum of \$30,917 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Provides funds for the establishment of a 5-member Human Rights Commission, one executive secretary and one clerk-stenographer with funds for legal counsel and related operating expense and equipment.

Sec. 6. Effective date. This Act shall be effective July 1, 1972.'
