IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Register of Deeds, Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the register of deeds of Penobscot County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the register of deeds in Penobscot County from \$6,000 to \$8,000.
