STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Sable (Marten) and Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The 6th paragraph of subsection I of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

There shall be an open season on fisher and sable during the month of November and December of each year. The commissioner may lengthen, shorten or close such fisher and sable season as he may deem necessary.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The 10th paragraph of subsection 1 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 21 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

There shall be no open season on sable (marten) and Canada lynx.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to provide an open season on sable each year and to authorize the commissioner to shorten or close the fisher and sable season as he deems necessary.
