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**AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to the Trustee of Wages.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 2602, sub-§ 6, repealed and replaced. Subsection 6 of section 2602 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 318 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

6. Earnings of wife or minor children. By reason of earnings due from him to the wife or minor children of the principal defendant.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals certain provisions of the present law relating to the trustee of wages which are in conflict with the federal Consumer Credit Protection Act (P. L. 90-321) which became effective on July 1, 1970.
