RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of One Hundred Copies of "Lisbon, the History of a Small Maine Town."

Lisbon, The History of a Small Maine Town; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$850 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled, "Lisbon, The History of a Small Maine Town," by Francis W. Plummer, Sr., said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
