RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of History of Cape Elizabeth.

History of Cape Elizabeth; purchase of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the "History of Cape Elizabeth" by William B. Jordan, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
