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**History of Cape Elizabeth; purchase of. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the "History of Cape Elizabeth" by William B. Jordan, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.
