STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Sagadahoc County: County commissioners, $\$_{1,250}$ $\$_{1,500}$; clerk of courts, $\$_{5,200}$ $\$_{6,000}$; county attorney, $\$_{7,500}$; county treasurer, $\$_{2,500}$ $\$_{3,000}$; sheriff, $\$_{6,000}$ $\$_{7,000}$; register of deeds, $\$_{5,500}$ $\$_{6,250}$; judge of probate, $\$_{4,800}$ $\$_{5,600}$; register of probate, $\$_{7,200}$ $\$_{6,000}$.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of the county officers of Sagadahoc County.
