COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 525, L. D. 687, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Provide a Shorter
Time for Establishing Voting Residence.

Amend said Resolution by striking out in the 10th and 11th
lines (9th and 10th lines of L. D.) the following: "~~six-months~~
thirty days" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'six
three months'

Further amend said Resolution by striking out in the 15th
and 18th lines (12th and 14th lines of L. D.) the underlined
word "ten" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word
'thirty'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change voting residence
in the State from six months to three months and in the
municipality from three months to thirty days.
