IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Lights While Locating or Taking Raccoon Found by a Dog.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

- R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 4, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 4 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - B. An electric flashlight of not more than 3 4 cells or 6 volt hand light or head lamp may be used while locating or taking the animal found by a dog; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to increase the amount of light permitted while locating or taking an animal found by a dog.
