STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Water Skiing Between Sunset and 9 a.m.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 281-A, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 281-A to read as follows:

§ 281-A. Water skiing at night

No person shall operate any watercraft for the purpose of towing a person or persons on water skis, surfboards or similar devices nor shall any person water ski, surfboard or use similar devices on any waters of this State between the hours of sunset and q a.m.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act would limit water skiing to the hours between 9 a.m. and sunset.
