STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Kents Hill School from the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

R. S., T. 5, § 1001, sub-§ 18, amended. Subsection 18 of section 1001 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

18. Public school. "Public school" shall mean any public school conducted within the State under the authority and supervision of a duly elected board of education, superintending school committee or school directors, and any school which received any direct state aid in 1950, and municipal tuition funds amounting to at least the amount of such state aid, during the same year, except that Maine Wesleyan Seminary & College, commonly known as Kents Hill School, as of the effective date of this Act, shall be excluded from such coverage as is extended by the Maine State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Participants at Kents Hill School have elected to contract for their own retirement program.
