SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 245, L. D. 706, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement of Liquor Inspectors."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of this paragraph, any person employed as a liquor inspector on or before September 3, 1965 who has been employed continuously as such and who will not attain the 25 years of creditable service at age 65, shall be permitted to continue in his employment as a liquor inspector in order to obtain the 25 years of creditable service necessary, at which time such liquor insepctor must be retired.'
