STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Effective Period for Filing of a Financing Statement under Uniform Commercial Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 11, § 9-403, sub-§ 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection 2 of section 9-403 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any other filed financing statement is effective for a period of 5 10 years from the date of filing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend from 5 years to 10 years the period that a financing statement is effective without the necessity to refile with a continuation statement. This will permit granting loans for longer periods of time with no extra cost of recording.
