COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 553, L. D. 729, Bill, "AN ACT Creating York County Commissioner Districts."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line (6th line of L. D.) the underlined word and comma "Arundel,"; and by striking out in the 7th line (6th line of L. D.) the underlined word and comma "Kennebunkport," and by striking out in the 10th line (9th line of L. D.) the underlined word and comma "Dayton,"; and by striking out all of the 13th and 14th lines (12th and 13th of L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Commissioner District number 3 consisting of the municipalities
of Arundel, Biddeford, Dayton, Kennebunkport, Old Orchard Beach
and Saco.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Members of the board of commissioners shall be residents of the commissioner district for which they are elected and shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the county.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition. The transition to the York County district system shall be made in the following manner: In 1972 a commissioner resident in district one shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. In 1974 a commissioner resident in district 2 shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. In 1976 a commissioner resident in district 3 shall be elected by the qualified

electors of the county. Thereafter elections shall continue in a manner so that each district shall have on the board of commissioners a resident elected by the county at large.'
