STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Driving of Deer While Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2462, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2462 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for more than 6 persons to participate in a joint hunt for deer, wherein an effort is made to drive deer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to aid in the effort to preserve deer.
