**AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Dumping Litter on Highways.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

**R. S., T. 17 § 2251, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 2251 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 83 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Any person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 **and not less than \$25** or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to establish a minimum fine for dumping litter.
