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**AN ACT to Provide a Minimum Wage for Students Employed at  
Summer Camps.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 3, ¶ F, repealed.** Paragraph F of subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 410 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 9, additional.** Section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 9 to read as follows:

9. Student employees at summer camps. Any individual employed at a summer camp who is regularly enrolled as a student in an educational institution shall be paid a minimum of 80% of the state minimum wage.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to repeal the student exemption and provide at least 80% of the state minimum wage to students working in summer camps.
