HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 570, L. D. 746, Bill, "AN
ACT to Remove the Numerical Exemption from the Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. Application. From October 15, 1971 to October 15,
1972 persons employed by those employers employing less than 4
employees in any day of the week shall be paid at a rate of no
less than \$1.40 an hour and from October 15, 1972 to October 15,
1973 such employees shall be paid at a rate no less than \$1.60
an hour and thereafter such employees shall be paid what the state
minimum wage for all other covered employees is then in effect.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a gradual
application in removing the numerical exemption from the minimum
wage law.
