COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 572, L. D. 748, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Parking on Paved or Improved Portions of  
Ways and Removal of Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word  
"reclaimed" in the 15th line (12th line of L. D.) the underlined  
words 'and mail a copy of the notice to the Chief of State Police'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 17th line  
(14th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "60" and inserting  
in place thereof the underlined figure '30'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the number of days  
the machine is on the premises. The Chief of State Police should  
be notified so that a check can be made to determine if the  
car is stolen.
