STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers of Portland Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1969, c. 107, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 107 of the private and special laws of 1969 is amended to read as follows:

In addition to its existing powers, the district is authorized to take, collect, hold, transmit, treat, purify, discharge and dispose of all sewage within said watershed area provided, however, that in disposing of any treated effluent into the Presumpseot River, said district shall discharge said effluent into said river at any point below North Gorham Dam, so called.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the Portland Water District to discharge treated effluent above the North Gorham Dam. This change will cut the cost of sewage disposal and abatement.
