STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Long-term Semipermanent Registration Plates for Certain Semitrailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. Section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, and as amended by chapter 163 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding after the first sentence, the following new sentence, to read as follows:

Said person, partnership or corporation must be Maine domiciled companies, or if they are not, must have a place of business and an address in Maine and must operate and register some truck-tractors in the State of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the use of the long-term semitrailer plate to persons or companies residing in or having a domicile in the State of Maine or operating in and out of the State of Maine.
