SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 238, L.D. 754, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Fees and Compensation of the State Board of Administrators
of Medical Care Facilities."

Amend said Bill in inserting before the enacting clause
the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as
emergencies; and

Whereas, all expenses of the Board of Administrators of Medical
Care Facilities are now paid from the General Fund; and

Whereas, such expenses should be paid from the fees collected
by the board, without any General Fund appropriation; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to more
efficiently carry out the legal duties of the board and since
examinations are scheduled in the near future this legislation should
be enacted as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement
of Fact the following emergency clause:

(Filing No. S-157)

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall become effective when approved.'
