COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 259, L.D. 765, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Reimbursement to Administrative Units for Unusual
Enrollment Increases."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
sentence (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the fol-
lowing sentence:

'In such a case, such pupils shall be counted for the purpose of
computing the subsidies allotted such a unit as if they had been
attending school in the administrative unit during the applicable
subsidy year.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to assist those local units
that face financial hardship due to unusual school enrollment
increases.
