HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 262, L. D. 768, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Maine Litter Control Act."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 2264." by inserting in the 4th line (same in L.D.) before the underlined punctuation and word ", which" the underlined words and punctuation 'or on the ice over such waters '

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 2264." by striking out in the 2nd and 3rd lines of the 2nd paragraph of subsection 2 (2nd in L.D.) the underlined words and figure "of not less than \$10" and inserting in place thereof 'of not more than \$100'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 2265." by striking out in the first and 2nd lines (first line in L.D.) of the 3rd paragraph "shall not be less than \$10" and inserting in place thereof 'shall not be more than \$100'

Statement of Fact

Current litter signs read "\$100 Littering Fine." This amendment is designed to allow the state and municipalities to retain the visual impact of present warning signs instead of substituting "\$10 minimum fine for littering."

This amendment will also make it illegal to litter on ice, as it is under the present law.
