HOUSE AMENDMENT " D " to S. P. 262, L. D. 768, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Maine Litter Control Act."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated section "§ 2272." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 2272. Local regulations

Municipalities of this State may adopt more stringent ordinances, laws or regulations dealing with subject matter of this chapter. Any less restrictive ordinances, laws or regulations now in effect dealing with the subject matter of this chapter and the minimum standards which it establishes are declared invalid and of no force and superseded by this chapter on its effective date.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is designed to allow municipalities and political subdivisions to enact more stringent litter controls than those imposed by this Act.
