STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 17th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, which relates to the salaries of the county officers of York County, is further amended to read as follows:

York County: County commissioners, \$2,250 \$3,500; clerk of courts, \$7,000 \$9,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$6,500; county attorney, \$8,000 \$10,000; first assistant county attorney, \$5,500 \$7,500; second assistant county attorney, \$5,500 \$7,500; county treasurer, \$2,250 \$3,500; sheriff, \$7,000 \$10,000; register of deeds, \$6,000 \$9,000; judge of probate, \$6,500 \$7,500; register of probate, \$4,750 \$6,250.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$15,000 to provide for the increases in salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorneys of York County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
