STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Beaver Trapping by Nonresidents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2360, amended. Section 2360 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law nonresidents shall not be permitted to trap beaver in this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Seven permits were issued to nonresident trappers of beaver. Beaver trapped by nonresidents do not bear the Maine beaver stamp. New Hampshire does not allow Maine residents to trap beaver in that state.
