STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Reimburse Municipalities for School Tax Effort.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Tax Effort Fund within the Department of Education the sum of \$2,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, for the purpose of reimbursing municipalities which equal or exceed the median school tax effort of the State under the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 3733, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 496 of the public laws of 1969.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The 104th Legislature by chapter 496 of the public laws of 1969 provided for aiding municipalities which were above average in their school tax efforts. The purpose of this bill is to provide funds to implement this law.
