AN ACT Increasing Payments to the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library of the Cumberland Bar Association Serving as a County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 27, § 224, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 224 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Cumberland County, is amended to read as follows:

Cumberland, ~~\$3,000~~ \$5,000 which shall be paid to the treasurer of the Cumberland Bar Association for the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library,

STATEMENT OF FACT

The last increase in the appropriation for the Cleaves Law Library was in 1961 when the amount was increased from \$2,000 to \$3,000. The cost of publication for the library has increased from \$5,670.75 in 1960 to \$11,955.80 in 1970. Because of the increased cost of books, an adjustment must be made in the appropriation in order to keep the library collection up to date.
