

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 270, L. D. 798, Bill, "AN ACT Creating Oxford County Commissioner Districts."

D. OF R

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 3 lines (2 lines in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 105-G, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 105-G, to read as follows:'

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the amending clause the underlined figure "<u>§ 105-F.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '§ 105-G.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§ 105-F.</u>" of section 1 by inserting after the last paragraph the following:

'Members of the board of commissioners shall be residents of the commissioner district for which they are elected and shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the county.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition. The transition to the Oxford County district system shall be made in the following manner: In 1972 a commissioner resident in district one shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. In 1974 a commissioner resident in district 3 shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. In 1976 a commissioner resident in district 2 shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. Thereafter elections shall continue in a manner so that each district shall have on the board of commissioners a resident elected by the county at large.' (Filing $Mo \cdot S-91$)

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3.
