COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 271, L. D. 799, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Testing of Vision and Hearing for School Pupils."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1
the following underlined paragraph:

'This section shall not apply to any child whose
parent objects thereto in writing on the grounds that such
examinations conflict with the child's religious tenets
and practice, unless there are reasonable and apparent
grounds suspecting that such child has a hearing or vision
deficiency.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for the
religious rights of certain sects.
