SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 600, L. D. 801, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Administrative Enforcement of the Municipal Public Employees Labor Relations Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 10. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry to carry out the purposes of this Act the sum of \$29,600. The breakdown shall be as follows:


