HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 620, L. D. 802, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise Laws Relating to Aviation."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 6-A. R. S., T. 6, § 3, sub-§ 18-A, additional.

Section 3 of Title 6 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 18-A to read as follows:

18-A. Commercial airports. "Commercial airports" means a public airport as defined in section 27-A.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 7. R. S., T. 6, § 3, sub-§§ 19-A and 19-B, additional.

Section 3 of Title 6 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding 2 new subsections 19-A and 19-B to read as follows:

19-A. Federal air regulations. "Federal air regulations" means the regulations of the Civil Aeronautics Board issued under the authority of the "Civil Aeronautics Act of 1938," as amended, or any federal regulations superseding those issued under the authority of that Act.

19-B. Heliport. "Heliport" means a place set aside for the landing and take off of helicopters.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide definitions for the terms "commercial airports" and "heliport" in the laws relating to aviation.
