HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 601, L. D. 803, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Applicability of Workmen's Compensation Law
to Employers of One or More Employees."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the first 3 lines after
the amending clause (first and 2nd lines in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "~~employers-who-employ-3-or-less-workmen
or-operatives-regularly-in-the-same-business---Said-section-shall
not-apply-to~~" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'employers ~~who-employ-3-or-less-workmen-or-operatives-regularly
in-the-same-business-~~ engaged in woods operations. Said section
shall not apply to'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the first 2 lines
after the amending clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "~~other-than-these-who-employ-3-or-less-employees
regularly-in-the-same-business~~" and inserting in place thereof
the following: ', other than those who-employ-3-or-less-employees
regularly-in-the-same-business engaged in woods operations'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt employers engaged
in woods operations.
