

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 601, L. D. 803, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Applicability of Workmen's Compensation Law to Employers of One or More Employees."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the first 3 lines after the amending clause (first and 2nd lines in L.D.) by striking out the following: "employers-who-employ-3-or-less-workmen or-operatives-regularly-in-the-same-business.--Said-section-shall not-apply-to" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'employers who-employ-3-or-less-workmen-or-operatives-regularly in-the-same-business. <u>engaged in woods operations</u>. Said section shall not apply to'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the first 2 lines after the amending clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the following: "other-than-those-who-employ-3-or-less-employees regularly-in-the-same-business" and inserting in place thereof the following: ', other than those who-employ-3-or-less-employees regularly-in-the-same-business engaged in woods operations'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt employers engaged in woods operations.
