SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 601, L.D. 803, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Applicability of Workmen's Compensation Law to  
Employers of One or More Employees."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the  
following underlined sentence: 'Section 3 shall not apply to  
employers who employ 3 or less employees in woods operations.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 2  
the following underlined sentence: 'Section 3 shall not apply to  
employers who employ 3 or less employees in woods operations.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to avoid any confusion and  
insure that section 3 of the Workmen's Compensation Act shall not  
apply to woods operators with 3 or less employees.
