HOUSE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 605, L.D. 807, Bill, "AN ACT
to Revise Laws Relating to Outdoor Advertising."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting after the word
"level" in the 8th line (6th line in L.D.) the underlined words
'or the crown of the road'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting before the
period at the end the underlined words 'or 25 feet above the crown
of the road'

level of travel.
